## AGM Note 2


Dear shell friends,

This is a last note to remind all our Members of our upcoming AGM and to provide final details concerning the event.

### Date, Time and Venue

The 2019 AGM:

- Will be held on 1 June 2019.
- Will start at 10:00 (10AM).
- Will be held at *Unitas* Netcare Hospital, Centurion.
- Will take place in the Lecture Room on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor (detailed directions in the Agenda).



Please take note of the change in venue from our most recent AGMs – and once again a big *thank you* to our Secretary, Anton Groenewald, for securing the venue for us free of charge. Anton also said he would arrange for validated parking tickets, so your parking for the day will also be free (read: “more auction money”).

### Agenda

### **Shell Exhibits**

I am always amazed at the level of creativity and inventiveness (is this even a word...?) on display at the AGMs. Even if you are not gunning for a trophy, you will still receive a certificate (a revived tradition) that you can display with pride somewhere in your home or office.

Just another reminder: we have not specified a specific *Theme* for the Exhibits at this year's AGM (we decided to leave this up to the Exhibitors). However, adjudication will, as before, take place within one of the following four *Categories*:

- *Category 1: Artistic*
- *Category 2: Scientific*
- *Category 3: Beginner*
- *Category 4: Shell Family, Genus or Species*



So, you need to decide beforehand within which of the above Categories your Exhibit will be entered for the award; an award will be bestowed within each Category. And, as before, you may bring along as many Exhibits as you can fit into your car boot and therefore enter as many Categories as you wish, but an Exhibit cannot “span” multiple Categories; you need a separate Exhibit per Category.

Please be sure to review the Society's Exhibit Guidelines for additional information, especially if you are aiming for an award.

I invite all our Members from far and near to attend the AGM. It is always an enjoyable event and a place where we can catch up with old friends and make new ones. Save up for the AGM and the expected shell trade and come and join in on the fun!
